General Membership Meeting Minutes

10/27/2010

I. Call to order

President Keith Ash called to order the General Membership meeting of the **Green Country Soccer Association at 7:04pm on 10/27/2010 in the offices of the Green Country Soccer Association.** Quorum was established at 674 votes.

II. Roll call

The following clubs were present: Bixby, Broken Arrow, Catoosa, Central Tulsa, Claremore, Metro Tulsa, Mayes County, Miami, Owasso, Union, Washington County.

The following clubs were absent: Beeline, Cleveland, Collinsville, Coweta, Drumright, Ft. Gibson, Goingsnake, Grand Lake, Inola, Mannford, Muskogee, Oologah, Porter, Sand Springs, Sapulpa, Skiatook, Stilwell, Tahlequah, Tulsa United, Verdigris, Wagoner

III. Approval of minutes from last meeting

Secretary/Treasurer Mark Usrey presented the minutes from the 8/25/2010 General Membership meeting in printed form. Washington County moved to accept as printed, Broken Arrow seconded. **Motion approved.**

IV. Officer Reports

- a) Jeanette Rooks reported that the Games and Disciplinary Committee had reviewed 4 coach ejections, 20 player ejections, resulting in 9 players called in for visits. Of these, 5 received additional suspensions. 1 red card was pulled due to player not being involved after investigating. The committee has made 22 game determinations.

She reported on some important issues with sitout verifications. There will be no more verification requests from G&D; it is the coach's responsibility to turn the form into G&D so that the player gets credit for the discipline.

Discussion from the floor regarding collection of game forms by the referee for misconduct reports.

- b) Doug Lynch reported that the next Competitive Commission meeting is scheduled for 11/3/2010. They will be discussing changes to standing resolutions pertaining to competitive rules. They will also conduct an election of officers and address other small issues..
- c) Robert Allen distributed a statistics sheet summarizing the 2010 Scholarship tournament. He has sent out 5 emails out asking for requests to host the 2011 tournament to Broken Arrow Soccer Club, Owasso Soccer Club, Union Soccer Club, Tulsa United Soccer Club, and Claremore Soccer Club. They were asked to return an email immediately if they were interested (and only 1 reply was received). Applications are due 10/30/2010. Open to all clubs that might be interested

providing they have the facilities. The Tournament will be held May 13-15, 2011 for the 2010/2011 academic year. He will be sending notices to club presidents listed on the website to host the 2011 GCSA Tournament.

- d) Mark Usrey presented financial statements for the organization and provided general comments about the condition of the organization. He discussed some tax misinformation floating around among the clubs and answered some general tax questions
- e) Keith Ash had no report.

- a) A discussion of proposed bylaw changes that were handed out was held and some suggestions from floor regarding changed to roster size for U12s, number of players eligible to play for the U16-19 age groups (18), etc., but no changes were made.

BASC moved to accept changes as printed, second by Union. **Motion approved.**

- b) Keith reminded the assemble that we were required to form nominations committee for the 2 upcoming elected Executive Board positions: President and Secretary/Treasurer. He asked for a volunteer to chair the committee. Julie Watkins (OK Texans) volunteered to chair the committee. Kaye Conley (Owasso Soccer Club) volunteered to server. Jim Weir (Broken Arrow Soccer Club) volunteered to server. Committee accepted by acclamation.
- c) Union Soccer Club led a discussion regarding the U7/U8 age groups. Current Green Book rules specify that the game is played in quarters, but they (and several other clubs) play in halves. They wanted to know if other clubs interested in moving the U7/U8 to a halves format (with free substitution). Discussion from the floor.
- d) A general comment from the floor recommends that each club hold a discussion with their clubs to discuss a clarification of the substitution rules for the U10 through U19 ages (stoppage vs. possession).
- e) Robert Allen asked the membership to review their links from the GCSA website. Make sure club presidents and registrars are current.
- f) Last day to play league games for the Fall 2010 season is 11/21.

VIII. Adjournment

Keith Ash adjourned the meeting at **8:01pm**.

GREEN COUNTRY SOCCER ASSOCIATION – BYLAWS STANDING RULES

RECOMMENDED REVISIONS: Presented August 25, 2010;

To Be Voted on October 27, 2010

NOTE: To eliminate lengthy listing of recommendations the following should be noted - Aside from grammar, punctuation, etc., changes, Game Card was added to all references to Official Roster/Game Form. Additionally, GCSA or GCSA Office Manager was substituted for Registration Committee, etc. where appropriate.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

Current:

Section 5. The President shall preside at all meetings of GCSA and shall be the general manager of GCSA. He shall appoint the Chairmen of all committees except the Nominating Committee, Games and Disciplinary Committee, Finance Committee, Registration Committee, and Competitive League Commission; subject to the advice and consent of the Board of Directors.

Recommended:

Section 5. The President shall preside at all meetings of GCSA and shall be the general manager of GCSA. He shall appoint the Chairmen of all committees except the Nominating Committee, Games and Disciplinary Committee, and Competitive League Commission; subject to the advice and consent of the Board of Directors.

Reasoning:

1) Do not have Finance or Registration Committees.

Current:

Section 9. The Secretary - Treasurer shall keep the records and minutes of all meetings of GCSA, give notice of meetings, and have general custody of the records of GCSA. In addition, the Secretary - Treasurer shall have oversight for the receipt and disbursement of, and accounting for, all funds of GCSA, which shall be kept in a bank (or banks) designated by the Board of Directors. The Secretary - Treasurer shall prepare for presentation at each Annual Meeting a financial statement of GCSA for the preceding year. The Secretary - Treasurer shall also be responsible for filing all GCSA tax forms pertaining to his term of office and shall serve as Chairman of the Finance Committee and shall be bonded.

Recommended:

Section 9. The Secretary - Treasurer shall keep the records and minutes of all meetings of GCSA (notices will be sent out by GCSA Office Manager), and have general custody of the records of GCSA. In addition, the Secretary - Treasurer shall have oversight for the receipt and disbursement of, and accounting for, all funds of GCSA, which shall be kept in a bank (or banks) designated by the Board of Directors. The Secretary - Treasurer shall prepare for presentation at each Annual Meeting a financial statement of GCSA for the preceding year. The Secretary - Treasurer shall also be responsible for filing all GCSA tax forms pertaining to his term of office and shall be bonded.

Reasoning:

- 1) There is no Finance Committee. Is he bonded? If not, needs to be provided by GCSA.

ARTICLE IV. OFFICERS

Current:

Section 10. At the regular meeting held in April and October, a Nominating Committee of three (3) members shall be elected by the membership. It shall be the duty of this committee to nominate candidates for the offices of GCSA and the respective office each director shall hold for the next term. The Nominating Committee shall notify the Membership of its recommendations not less than seven (7) days prior to the January Meeting and the August Membership Meeting. The offices of President, Registrar and Secretary - Treasurer shall be elected at the January Meeting. The offices of First Vice President, Second Vice President and Third Vice President shall be elected at the August Membership Meeting. Before an election, additional nominations from the floor shall be permitted.

Recommended:

Section 10. At the regular meeting held in April and October, a Nominating Committee of three (3) members shall be elected by the membership. It shall be the duty of this committee to nominate candidates for the offices of GCSA and the respective office each shall hold for the next term. The Nominating Committee Chairman shall notify the Membership of its recommendations not less than seven (7) days prior to the January Meeting and the August Membership Meetings. The offices of President, and Secretary - Treasurer shall be elected at the January Meeting. The offices of First Vice President, Second Vice President and Third Vice President shall be elected at the August Membership Meeting. Before an election, additional nominations from the floor shall be permitted.

Reasoning:

- 1) Reference to "director" not necessary. Chairman is who speaks at the Membership Meeting. No longer a Registrar as an officer.

ARTICLE V. MEMBERSHIP MEETINGS

Current:

Section 1. There shall be a meeting of Members at 7:30 p.m. on the fourth Thursday of the months of January, April, August and October.

Recommended:

Section 1. There shall be a meeting of Members at 7:00 p.m. during the last full week of the months of January, April, August and October.

Reasoning:

- 1) Due to poor attendance on the previously designated Thursdays (apparent practice conflicts) hoped this would be more suitable for our Members' attendance.

ARTICLE VI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Current:

Section 3. The Board of Directors shall appoint an Attorney, and an Auditor to advise GCSA.

Recommended:

ARTICLE VI. BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Current:

Section 4. Unless otherwise ordered by the Board of Directors, regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held on the first Thursday of each month.

Section 4. Unless otherwise ordered by the Board of Directors, regular meetings of the Board of Directors shall be held during the first week of each month unless agreed to by majority of the Board of Directors.

Reasoning:

1) Due to conflicts of scheduling first Thursday or even first week of month may not always be workable.

ARTICLE VII. COMMITTEES

Current:

Section 3. Registration Committee

- a. Shall consist of the GCSA Office Registrar, Competitive Commission Registrar and three members appointed by the Chairman, subject to approval by the Board of Directors.
- b. Shall be responsible for approving Team Formation guidelines and monitoring compliance by Members.
- c. Shall be responsible for registering all GCSA players and coaches with the Oklahoma Soccer Association.

Recommended:

REMOVE.

Reasoning:

1) There is no Registration Committee.

ARTICLE VII. COMMITTEES

Current:

Section 7. Finance Committee

- a. Shall consist of the Chairman and members as appointed by the Chairman, subject to approval by the Board of Directors.

- b. Shall be responsible for preparing a budget for the fiscal year to be submitted and voted upon at the August meeting.

Recommended:
REMOVE.

Reasoning:

- 1) There is no Finance Committee.

SECTION II. REGISTRATION

Current:

C. Teams

4. An "Official" roster shall be the "GCSA Roster and Game Form", approved by a member of the GCSA Registration Committee, initialed and stamped with the three official GCSA stamps. No changes shall be made on these forms without the official stamp being placed in the appropriate space by a member of the GCSA Registration Committee. *[Also applies to the GCSA Competitive League.]*

Recommended:

4. An "Official" roster shall be the "GCSA Roster/Game Form/Game Card", approved by GCSA. Once roster is frozen, GCSA's stamp appears when printed. *[Also applies to the GCSA Competitive League.]*

SECTION III. TEAMS

NOTIFICATION ONLY

Current:

A. Size

- b. Recreational teams (U12 – U14) shall be formed with a minimum of ten (10) players and a normal maximum of fifteen (15). The Club may elect to extend the maximum number of players to eighteen (18) per team.
- c. U16 – U19 teams shall be formed with a minimum of ten (10) players and up to twenty-two (22) as a maximum.

Recommended:

- b. Recreational teams (U12 – U14) shall be formed with a minimum of eleven (11) players and a normal maximum of eighteen (18) players per team.
- c. U16 – U19 teams shall be formed with a minimum of eleven (11) players and a maximum of twenty-two (22) players.

Reasoning:

- 1) THIS WAS ACTUALLY CHANGED AT THE 08/28/2008 Membership meeting and never was corrected in the Green Book. This aligns our GCSA Bylaws with the current USYSA Policy on Players and Playing Rules, Rule 205. Roster Limitations.

SECTION III. TEAMS

- a. A team's head coach shall be allowed to have his child (children) placed onto his team.
- b. Each team shall be allowed to have one child (children) of one assistant coach placed on his team per seasonal year.

In order to maintain and support an atmosphere of fun and education, GCSA shall not recognize game results or league standings in the U6/U8 divisions. GCSA shall recognize each individual player in the U6/U8 division with an award each season.

If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be returned. *[Also applies to the GCSA Competitive League]*

Recommended:

The protesting coach shall deliver his Official Roster/Game Form/Game Card (or written protest in lieu of no place to document protest on form after making referee aware of intentions) and a protest fee of \$50.00 (in cash, money order or certified check made payable to GCSA – no personal or team checks accepted) to the GCSA office by 2 p.m. of the next business day following the date of the game. If the protest is upheld, the protest fee will be returned. *[Also applies to the GCSA Competitive League]*

- 1) Added "Game Card", designated written protest since at this time there is no place on the new forms for that to be documented, clarified no team or personal checks will be accepted. No team or personal checks will also be added in the Appeals section.

 2. If a person violates #1, above, of this Bylaw, the offending party is subject to suspension and shall be liable to GCSA for all expenses, including attorney fees, incurred by the Association and its officers in defending each court action.
